Report on Student Satisfaction Survey 2021-22

Introduction and Objectives:

Shri Swami Vivekanand Shikshan Sanstha's Shikshanmaharshi Dr. Bapuji Salunkhe College, Miraj. was established in 1965 . The overall development of the urban and rural students is the motto of the institution. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell and Feedback Committee of the college have conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey regarding Teaching – Learning and Evaluation and overall institutional performance for the academic year 2021-22. It will help to upgrade the quality of Teaching-Learning and Evaluation and facilities provided by the institute. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these students is important as both are crucial for monitoring the quality assurance. Suggestions given by the students are contributing factors for smooth running of the institution. The present survey tries to capture students' responses about teaching-learning and other facilities in the institution in order to take necessary measures for quality enhancement.

Methodology

By the end of academic year 2021-22, the link of Students Satisfaction Survey form (SSS) was made available on college website and WhatsApp group or respective classes. Students were notified to fill the questionnaire. The questionnaire including 21 questions was prepared as per the guidelines of NAAC. Filing of SSS is voluntary/ optional. For the academic year 2021-22, there were 1939 registered students at the college. Four hundred and fifty one (451) students responded to the survey, providing a response rate of 23.31% The analysis presented in this report is based on the responses of the 451 respondents to the survey.

Respondent Profile

The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to class and course. There are 32.2% from B.A., 45.6% from B. Com., 33.8 % from B.Sc., 0.4% from M.Com. 5.2 % from M.Sc. respondents in the survey sample.

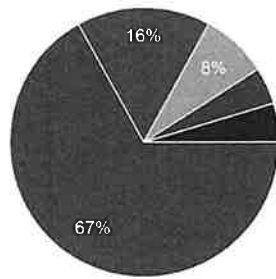
About Teaching –Learning Process:

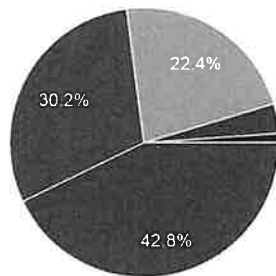

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

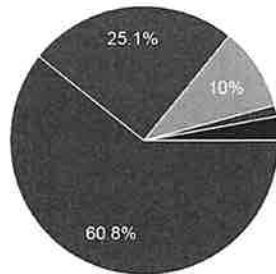

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

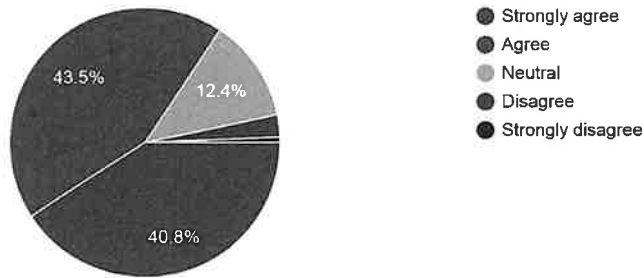

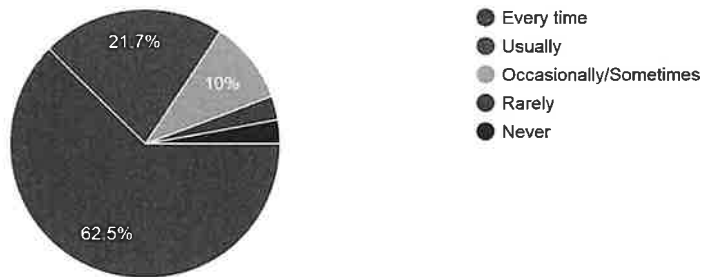
9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

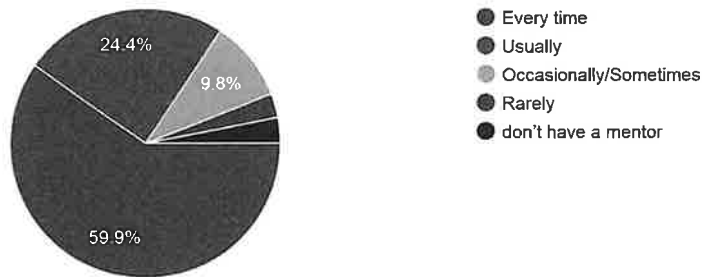
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

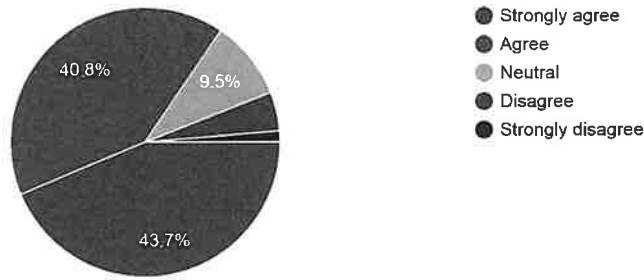
11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

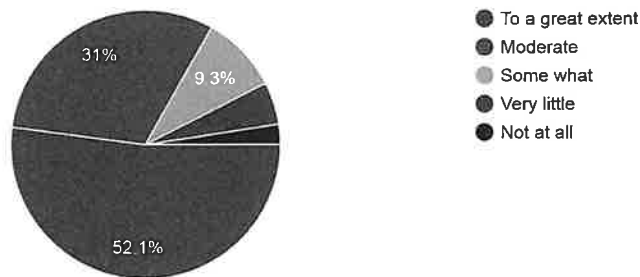
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

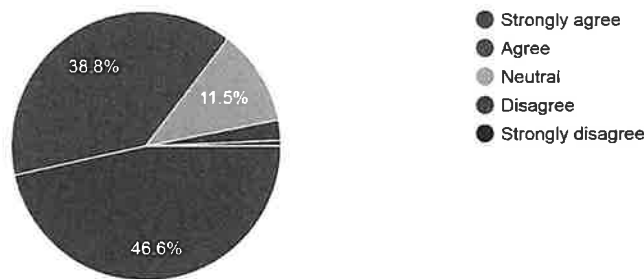
